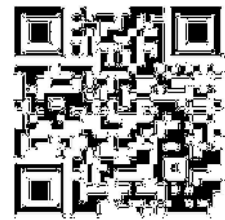


## Important information for travellers

In order to contain the corona epidemic the Hessian state government has introduced regulations which include restrictions in various areas of life. These rules are binding for all persons residing in Hessen. Further information is available at [www.hessen.de](http://www.hessen.de).

### The following regulations apply to all persons entering Hessen from a risk area

1. If you enter Hessen from abroad and have stayed in a **risk area** during the 14 days prior to your entry, you must go home or to your accommodation immediately. There you must go into **quarantine for 14 days**. This means that you are not allowed to leave your home / accommodation during this time. The same rule applies if you enter Hessen via another federal state. **Risk areas** are designated by the Robert Koch Institute: <https://www.rki.de/covid-19-risikogebiete>
2. If you are entering from a risk area, you are obliged to **present a medical certificate confirming that there is no evidence of infection with the SARS Cov-2 virus**.
3. If you **cannot provide proof**, you **must consent to a test**. You can have this test performed at the **test centre in the AiRail - Check In** at Frankfurt Airport. The test is **free of charge**.
4. You **must remain in quarantine at home or in your accommodation** until the test results are available. The **obligation to quarantine does not apply** if your **test result is negative** for infection with the SARS-CoV-2 virus.
5. If you enter from a risk area, you are **obliged to inform** the **responsible health authority** for your place of residence/accommodation about your **entry, your contact details and the test result**. You must immediately inform the Health Department again if symptoms of a disease with COVID-19 occur, even if the test result was negative. You comply with the obligation to provide your contact details by accurately filling out the exit ticket provided. 6. We recommend that you have a **second free test after 5 to 7 days**. You can also do this with a suitable registered doctor.



Risk areas

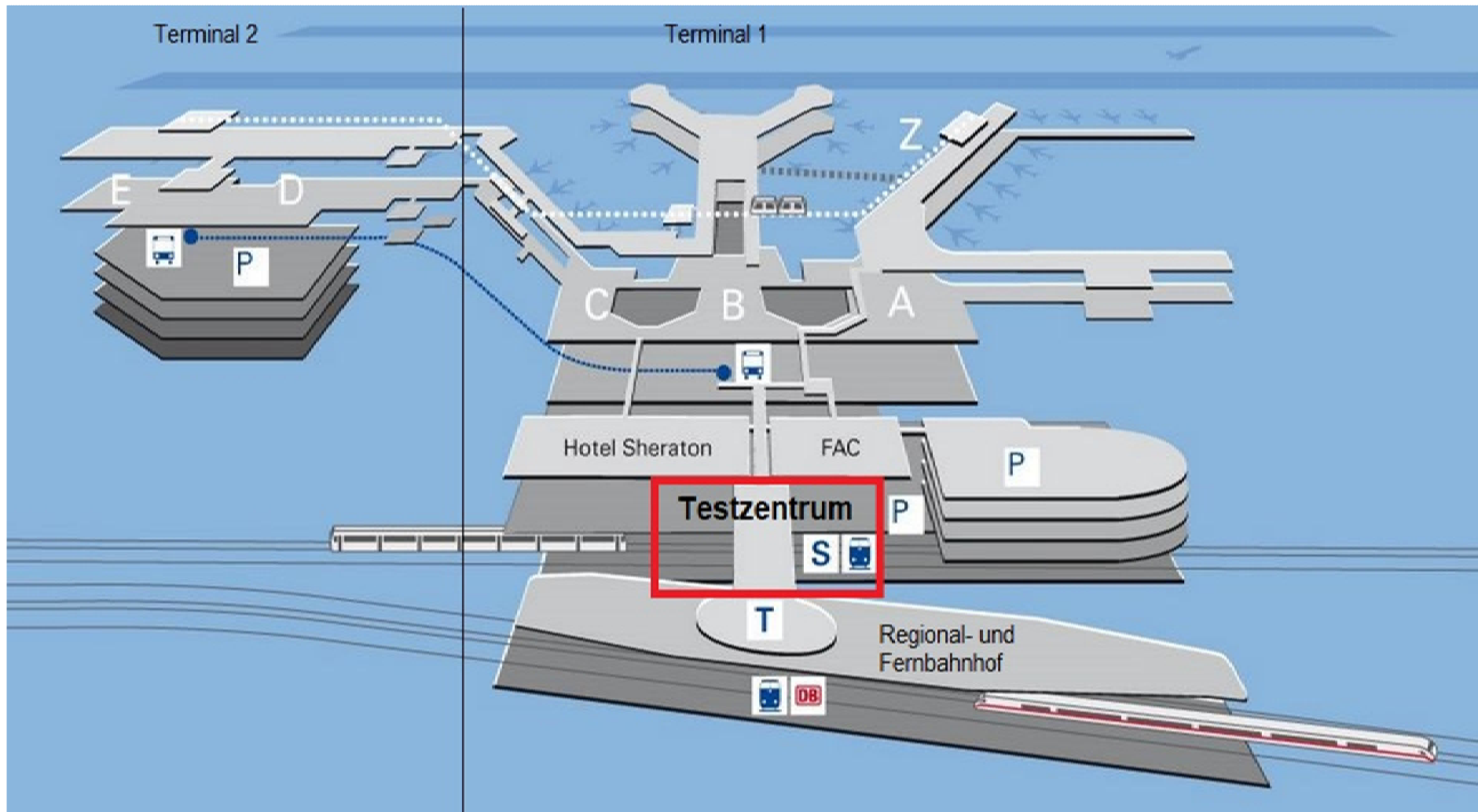
### No obligation to quarantine exists for, among others

- Employees of transport and transport companies who have been abroad for less than 72 hours or who have been in Hessen for less than 48 hours.
- Travellers in transit, these must leave Hessen by the most direct route.

**Violations of these regulations can be punished with a fine of up to € 25,000.**
