

You can purchase medical-grade facemask

KN 95 / N95 or FFP2 in these shops:

Since January 23, 2021, everyone has been required to wear a medical-grade facemask (type KN 95/N95 or FFP2) in all terminal areas and inside buses and people mover trains. Simple homemade face coverings are no longer sufficient. Medical-grade masks can be purchased in all Relay and Hub Convenience stores and pharmacies and from vending machines at the airport.
